## Principal's Update - Mr. Furman

- Parent-teacher conference sign-ups are still open for scheduling.
- Staff will make additional efforts to keep the conferences on schedule.
- Mr. Furman will send out an email later tonight about how things will work during PT conferences.
- Forecasting for 5<sup>th</sup> graders is upon us. The elective portion of the forecasting form is a bit confusing, guidance is needed. Communication might be going home to parents about how to complete; might be difficult since MP does not have access to communication outlets to 5<sup>th</sup> graders at the various local elementary schools who feed into MP.
- MP has considered the ramifications and plan for potential future walkouts that are being organized by various groups.
- The PTO suggested sending out a communication to Meadow Park families regarding the impact of the May 2018 Levy.

## Treasurer's Report - Leslie

- 8<sup>th</sup> grade party income; with the up and coming popcorn sales at various concerts, McTeacher Night (4/17/18) and money still coming in from parent donations, the PTO is on track to raise all the funds needed for the party.
- PBIS market is back, but is now on wheels. Some teachers have their own classroom stores where students can choose items as a reward for positive behavior. Budget for the PBIS line item is \$1,000; \$154.05 has been spent. Waiting on possible receipts to be forwarded to PTO for reimbursement.
- Up and coming expenses related to food provision for staff:
  - PT Conf on Wed (3/14): Snacks and dessert Google Sheet sign-up has been sent out (no PTO funds used)
  - PT Conf on Thurs (3/15): Pizza dinner (approx. cost \$230 to the PTO).
    - Carol is gathering pizza preferences from staff and will pass along info to Jenna
    - Jenna will order pizzas (24 hours in advance, if possible)
    - Leslie will pick up pizzas around 4:30p and deliver to MP
    - Jenna will drop off gluten-free meal for 5 staff
  - Teacher Appr on Mon (5/7): Lunch taco bar provided by Bethany Bistro (Cost \$350 to the PTO). Jenna will coordinate with Cassie.
  - Teacher Appr on Tues (5/8): Bfast provided by the PTO (maybe items from Costco, Einstein bagel donations, muffins, yogurt, coffee, etc.)
  - Remaining "Staff Appreciation" line item funds to be used by Leadership to provide something to staff.

## Jog-a-thon 2018 - Leslie

- Tara is going to be the point person for this event (the PTO's largest fundraiser of the year).
- Would be great to set a date for this sooner, rather than later. This is made more challenging with the unknown outcome of the Levy at this point in time.
- Ask Jared to provide the PTO with a ballpark date.

## Book Fair volunteers - Leslie

- Book fair will take place during PT conferences (3/14 and 3/15). 3/14 5:30p-8p. 3/15 8:30a-12p and 2:30p-8p.
